A message from the Interim Moderator

Dear Friends,

In recent weeks several people have asked about reopening the church for worship, wondering why it is taking so long. Alas, the time scale is down to Scottish Government and Church of Scotland Guidance and the procedures we must follow before we can open.

However, at a Kirk Session meeting on 28th July, the Kirk Session appointed a small working group to oversee the actions required following our Covid-19 Risk Assessment. At their first meeting they set a deadline of Sunday 23rd August for the first opening of the church for worship and since then they have been working to put the necessary infrastructure in place to enable us to follow the Guidelines.

Unfortunately, we will be

limited to a maximum of fifty at each service and we have to record details of everyone who attends.

We have therefore decided that everyone who wished to come to the church service in person will have to 'book' a place by contacting Alison in the Church Office by phone or by email. Further details in side.

For those who don't wish (or are unable) to come the service in the building there will continue to be recorded services online and sent out by DVD.

Initially, places at worship will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis, but there will then be an option for those unable to attend one week to be first in the queue the following week.

Government Guidance will also limit what we can do during worship, the most obvious change being the absence of singing. However, we can still have music and we can project

material onto the screen, so a shorter but meaningful service will still be possible.

Sunday services will be at 10.30am with entry via the glass doors on the north side of the church, but to avoid the close contact of queuing, it would be best if everyone does not arrive at the last minute. Please note that after worship the church will be closed for 72 hours before weekly cleaning takes place. This gives time for any viral contamination to become inactive.

We appreciate your patience during this difficult time, but please be assured that our first priority continues to be the safety of our members and worshippers. In this regard, please do not come to worship if you are feeling unwell or have any covid symptoms.

The 'How –To' of coming to church services in person

1) Book your place

At present Government regulations allow for services of worship to include up to 50 people. In order not to have to turn anyone away, and to make sure we are able to comply with 'Track and Trace' processes, those coming to a service must book a place through the church office.

You can email Alison at church.office@btconnect.com with your name, contact number and details of everyone who is hoping to attend.

Alternatively you can phone 01382 737294 from 10am-12.30pm on weekdays, or leave a message on the answering machine.

In the unfortunate situation that worship is 'full' you will be given priority the next week.

If there is space, someone will let you know. Please avoid coming on Sunday morning if you haven't been told there is a space for you. It would be heartbreaking for us to have to consider turning people away.

2) Coming on the day

Please come to Church wearing a face covering (unless there is an exception that prevents you wearing one).

There will be clear signage and instructions as you enter the building. Please use the disinfectant hand gel stations as you enter and leave.

It is important that we maintain a 2-metre physical distance in and around the church building. We will have special procedures in place to help us achieve that, and you will be directed to a specific seat when you arrive to maintain the spacing requirements.

3) Worship God

It will be strange. It will not be 'back to normal'. Nonetheless, God loves us and we will return that love in our worship.
